



2020 Mike Grimm Honorary Scholarship

Information & Purpose:

The Rifle Sportsmen's Club, a non-profit organization, is committed to ensuring that future generations may continue enjoy shooting sports. The Club is proud to once again offer Scholarship Awards for the 2020-2021 school year. Funds will be allocated to one or more recipients who meet the criteria established by the Scholarship Committee. All applicants will be scored on each section of the Scholarship Application and given an overall score. Award recipient(s) will be notified in early July 2020.

This Scholarship is intended for educational purposes at any College, University, or Technical School. The Scholarship is to be used for tuition, books, or other fees necessary for attendance at one of the aforementioned institutions. The Scholarship Award will be paid directly to the institution of the award recipient's attendance. Awards not claimed by 10/31/2020 will be forfeited and distributed to runners-up, if any. The RSC Board of Directors may amend amounts or scoring guidelines as deemed necessary.

Eligibility:

Any high school senior residing within Garfield County, Colorado, who is planning to attend a College, University, or Technical School in the fall of 2020; any previous RSC Scholarship Award recipient who has been continuously enrolled in a higher education program, but for no more than four prior years, for a maximum of five years of scholarship awards; any individual who is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States and previously attended a high school in Garfield County, Colorado and who is under the age of 25 years old.
